### Common Hazards



#### Tripping Hazards

Loose objects on floors can cause trips and falls



#### Slippery Surfaces

Wet or slippery floors can cause dangerous falls



#### Falling Objects

Improperly stored items can fall and cause injury



#### Fire Hazards

Accumulated waste materials increase fire risk



## What You Can Do



Keep floors clean and free of litter, dust, and trash



Store tools and equipment properly when not in use



Store chemicals and flammables according to procedures



Use covered containers for oily rags disposal

- ✓ Orderly arrangement of materials
- ✓ Designated place for each item
- ✓ Proper waste disposal systems
- ✓ Regular cleaning schedule
- ✓ Adequate work space maintenance
